# 1. Purpose

---

Ithaca's Discovery Trail (DT) consists of eight members: Cayuga Nature Center, Cornell Lab of Ornithology, Cornell Plantations, The History Center in Tompkins County, Johnson Museum of Art, Museum of the Earth at PRI, Sciencenter, and Tompkins County Public Library. The Discovery Trail, in association with the Convention and Visitors Bureau and the Strategic Tourism Planning Board would like to better understand who the current visitors to the eight members of the Discovery Trail are. The overall goal is to increase attendance at these eight Discovery Trail locations. A survey was conducted in July 2008 and this study is a follow-up to determine the impact of the marketing strategies that were implemented.

## 2. Methodology

---

### Objectives

The specific objective of the survey was to gather basic information from visitors to the eight Discovery Trail locations to get a gauge of who these visitors are. A very short face-to-face interview (see *Appendix A*) was conducted with individuals who were visiting each of the eight locations during the month of July, 2008. This is a follow-up study to a study originally conducted in July, 2004.

### Sampling

It was desired to obtain a random sample of visitors to the eight Discovery Trail locations during the month of July. Survey data was collected at each location at four different times across days of the week and times within the day. See *Appendix B* for a detailed survey schedule. The goal was to survey at least 15 visitors at each location at each time period for a minimum of 60 interviews per location overall. Interviewers were posted at each location for three hours and instructed to conduct as many interviews as possible during this three hour period. Below is the number of completed interviews per location. The goal was to complete 60 interviews at all locations except for the Cayuga Nature Center and the History Center. There were not enough visitors to either of these two places for the interviewers to meet the targets within the allocated time.

Over half of all respondents indicated they or members of their party were from out-of-county, where out-of-county was defined as residing any place outside of Tompkins County (TC) (see *Appendix A* for a list of zip codes defining Tompkins County on the questionnaire). A Tompkins County resident indicated a Tompkins County zip code otherwise they were coded as not being from Tompkins County. A Tompkins County resident can have non-residents in their party so the numbers of respondents who are not Tompkins County residents and those respondents with non-residents in their party varies.

## Data Analysis

### Reporting of Results

Presented in this report are the frequency of responses by question by location and whether or not they lived in Tompkins County. Percentages reported exclude those who refused or did not answer a particular question.

### 3. Executive Summary

---

The survey was conducted during the month of July, 2008.

#### Who completed the survey?

A total of 426 visitors at the following locations:

Among all visitors, the Sciencenter is where the larger party sizes on average were, with most parties consisting of 2 adults and 2 children, while The History Center and the Tompkins County Public Library were the locations with the smallest party sizes (averaging 1 adult and no children).

Among non-resident visitors, the largest average party sizes can be found at the Sciencenter and the Cayuga Nature Center (2 adults, 2 children), while the History Center and the Tompkins County Public Library are visited by the smallest party sizes (average 1 adult and no children).

Overall, the top sources of awareness about the area are living here or nearby and friends or family. After that, driving by and referral played a major role. Only a small fraction of respondents cited a website as a way that they heard about the site. Thus, marketing efforts should be concentrated on residents to encourage Discovery Trail as a destination for visits by family and friends in Tompkins County.

For non-residents specifically, who make up over half of those visiting the various Discovery Trail locations, word-of-mouth from friends or family in the area is clearly the main source of information for these visitors as they decide what to do during their visit. Meanwhile, residents are impacted both by just living in the area (and what they see and hear around town) as well as by their friends and family members. Clearly, then, having a strong focus on customer satisfaction is critical. There is also a significant opportunity to heighten awareness of the Discovery Trail concept, as two-fifths (41.5%) of residents and almost three-quarters of non-residents (73.4%) have not heard of the Discovery Trail. The Tompkins County Public Library and the Cayuga Nature Center had the lowest percentage of visitors from out-of-county and had one of the highest differences in the awareness of the nonresidents against Tompkins County residents.

## 4. Demographics

---

### Where do visitors reside?

Most of the visitors surveyed at Discovery Trail attractions were *not* from Tompkins County (37.3% reside in the county, 62.7% reside outside the county).

Visitors were asked if any of the members in their party were from out-of-county. More than two-thirds (66.7%) of all respondents indicated they *or* members of their party were from out-of-county. Table 1 reports the number of respondents who said they had members in their party from out-of-county by location. The locations where there were more out-of-county visitors were Sciencenter (84.2%), Museum of the Earth (80%), and the Johnson Museum of Art (77.8%). Fewer out-of-county visitors were found at Tompkins County Public Library (25.8%) and the History Center (50.0%).

For those who reported having some members of their party from out-of-county, they were then asked how many of these were adults 18 years or older, and how many were children, under 18 years of age.

Out of *all* visitors with out-of-county guests (whether or not they themselves indicated they lived in Tompkins County), the average out-of-county party size was 2 adults and 1 child (see Table 2). The Sciencenter had the largest average party sizes of out-of-county guests, with parties generally consisting of 2 adults and 2 children and the History Center is where the smallest party sizes were averaging 1 adult and no children (note that the History Center has a very small sample size). The number of children in the out-of-county parties varied across location, with the Cornell Plantations, the Cornell Lab of Ornithology, and the Tompkins County Public Library having on average no children in the out-of-county parties.

Looking at party size only of those who were not from Tompkins County, again the average out-of-party size consisted of 2 adults and 1 child over all the Discovery Trail locations (see Table 3). The Cayuga Nature Center and the Sciencenter are where the larger party sizes on average were, with parties consisting of 2 adults and 2 children overall, while The History Center and the Tompkins County Public Library were the locations with the smallest party sizes (averaging 1 adult and no children). At all the other locations, the party sizes consisted of 2 adults on average. The number of children in the out-of-county parties varied more across location, with the Cornell Lab of Ornithology, Tompkins County Public Library, and the History Center having, on average, no children in the out-of-county parties. The Cornell Plantations, Johnson Museum of Art, and the Museum of the Earth had 1 child on average in the parties, while the Sciencenter and the Cayuga Nature Center averaged 2 children per party.

The source of the data in Table 4 is from 2008 Claritas. Using the Claritas data, for each zip code the mean household income, median household income, mean household size and median household size was provided. Looking at the average of all the average household incomes across the zip codes, those visitors not from Tompkins County had significantly higher average household incomes than those visitors who reside in Tompkins County (\$79,004 vs. \$64,123 respectively). Although the minimum average household income for those who do not reside in Tompkins County was significantly less than those who reside in Tompkins County (\$12,500 vs. \$51,925 respectively), the maximum average household income is more than three times the maximum average income in Tompkins County (\$234,233 vs. \$76,777). Looking at average household size, there is not any significant difference between Tompkins County residence and non-Tompkins County residence (2.4 vs. 2.5 respectively).

# 5. Results

---

## A. How Did They Hear About the Discovery Trail Location?

Visitors were asked how they heard about the place they were visiting. Figures 1-9 show the percentages reporting how they heard about the location.

Overall, 63.1% of Tompkins County residents have been to the location before. Non-Tompkins County residents, on the other hand, cite friends/family as the predominant source of their awareness (33.1%). After that, non-residents have been to the location before (23.3%) or drove by the location (14.3%).

Unlike in 2006, very few respondents cited “other” sources of awareness.

Key differences in source of awareness by location include the following (See Table 5):

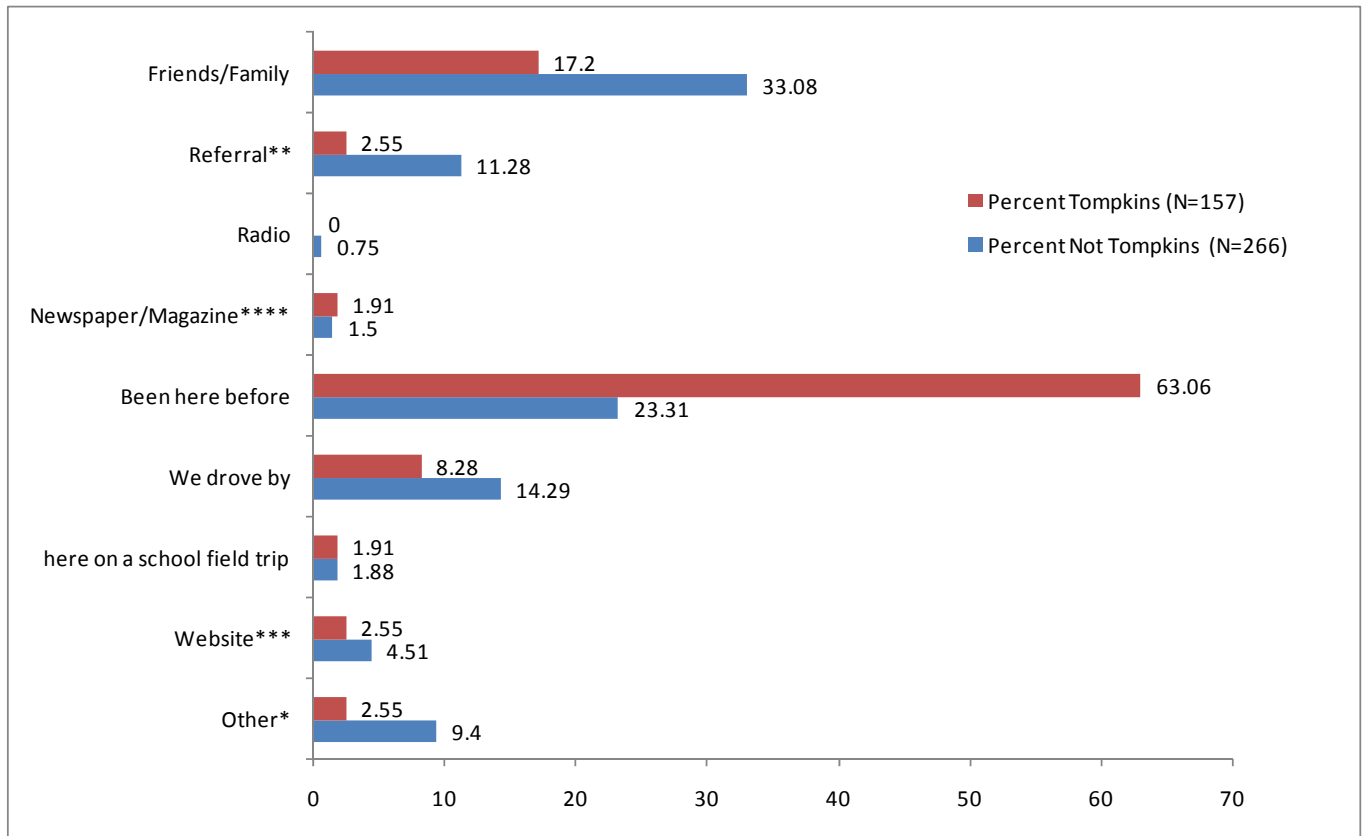

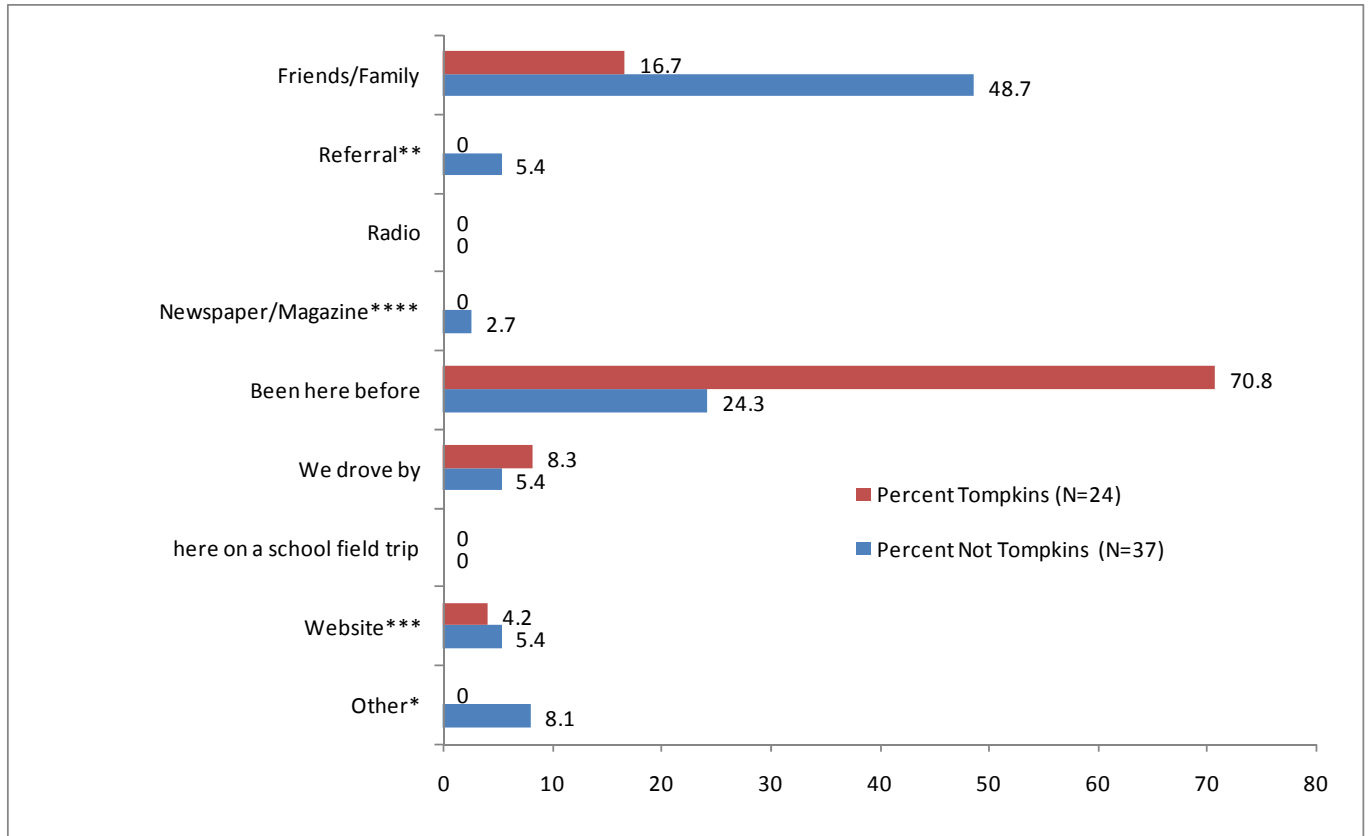

**Figure 1: How They Heard of Discovery Trail Location (All Locations)**



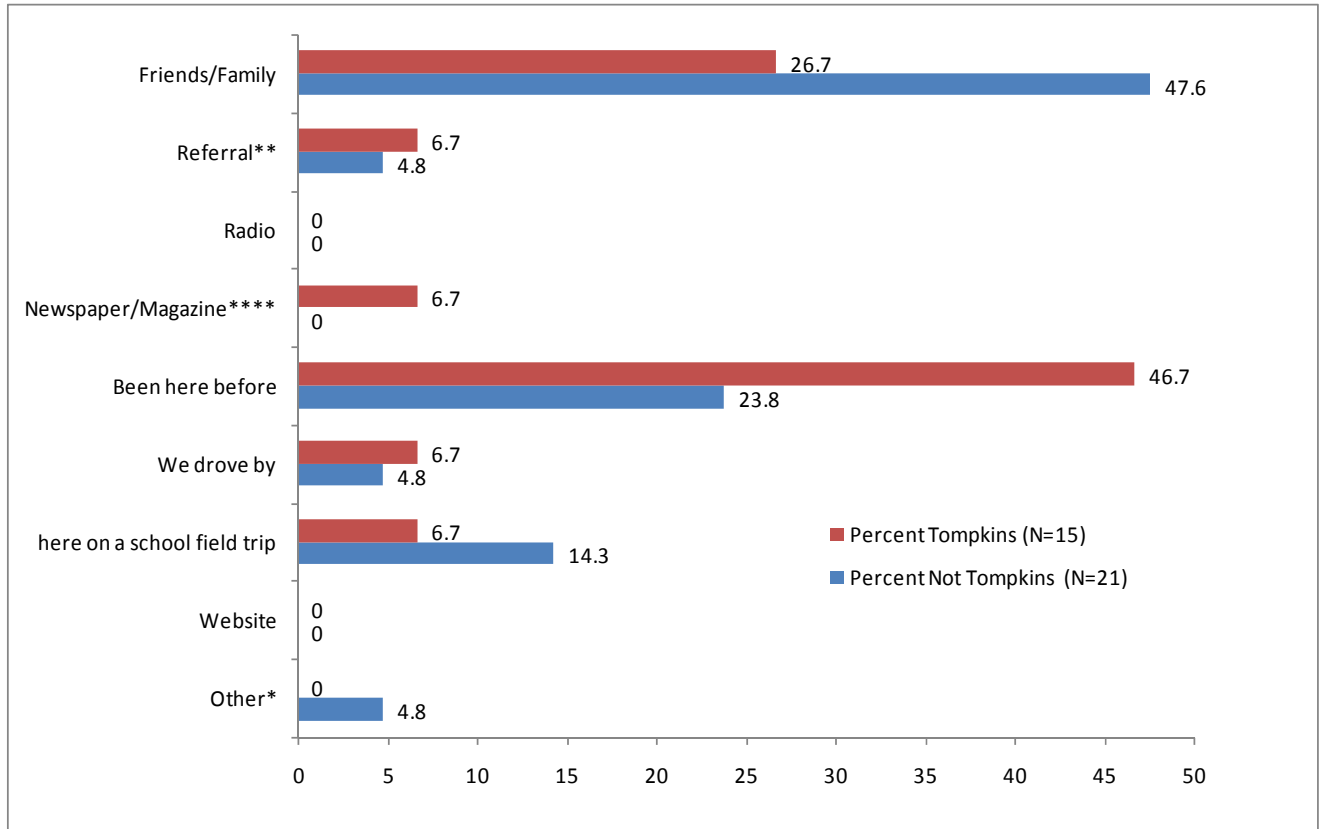

**Figure 2: How They Heard of Discovery Trail Location (Cornell Lab of Ornithology)**



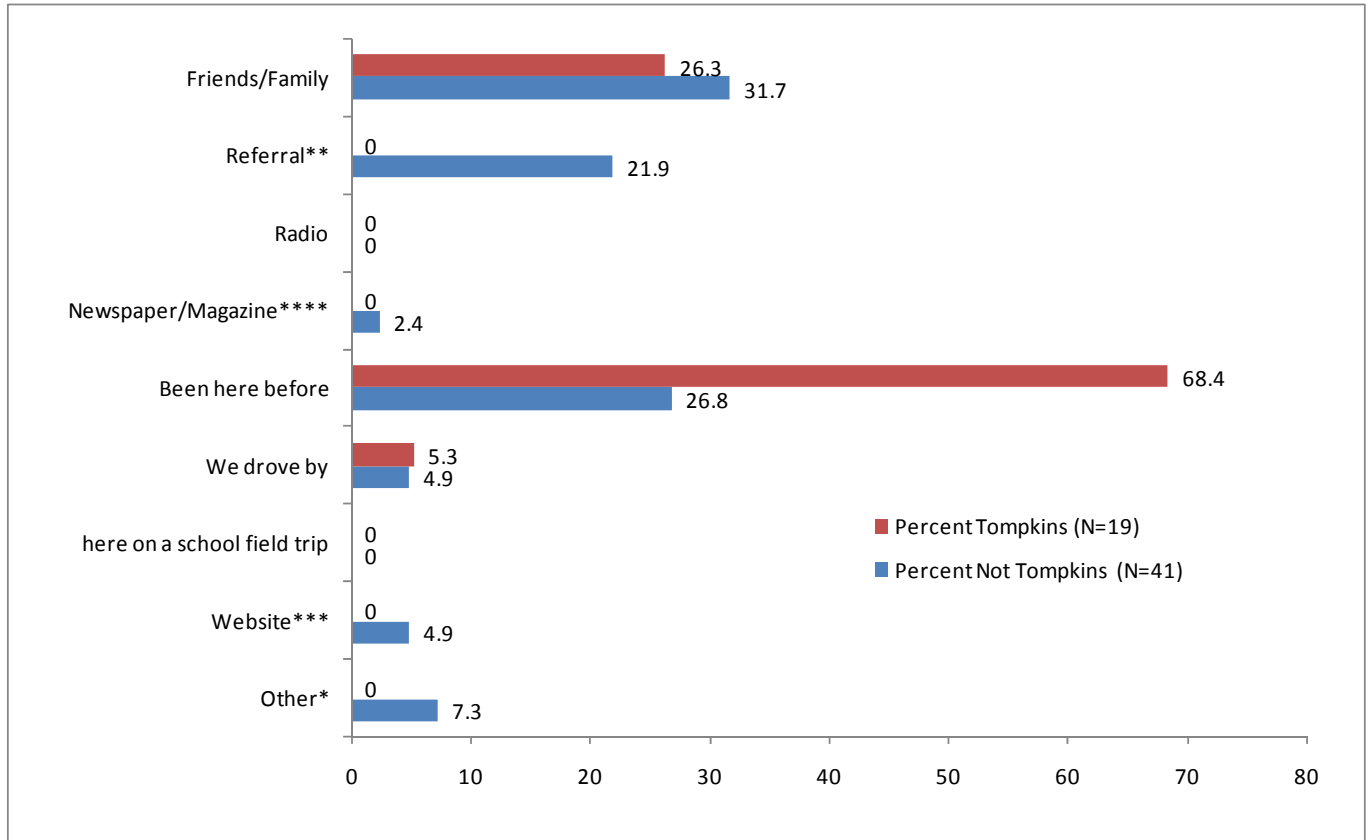

**Figure 3: How They Heard of Discovery Trail Location (Cayuga Nature Center)**



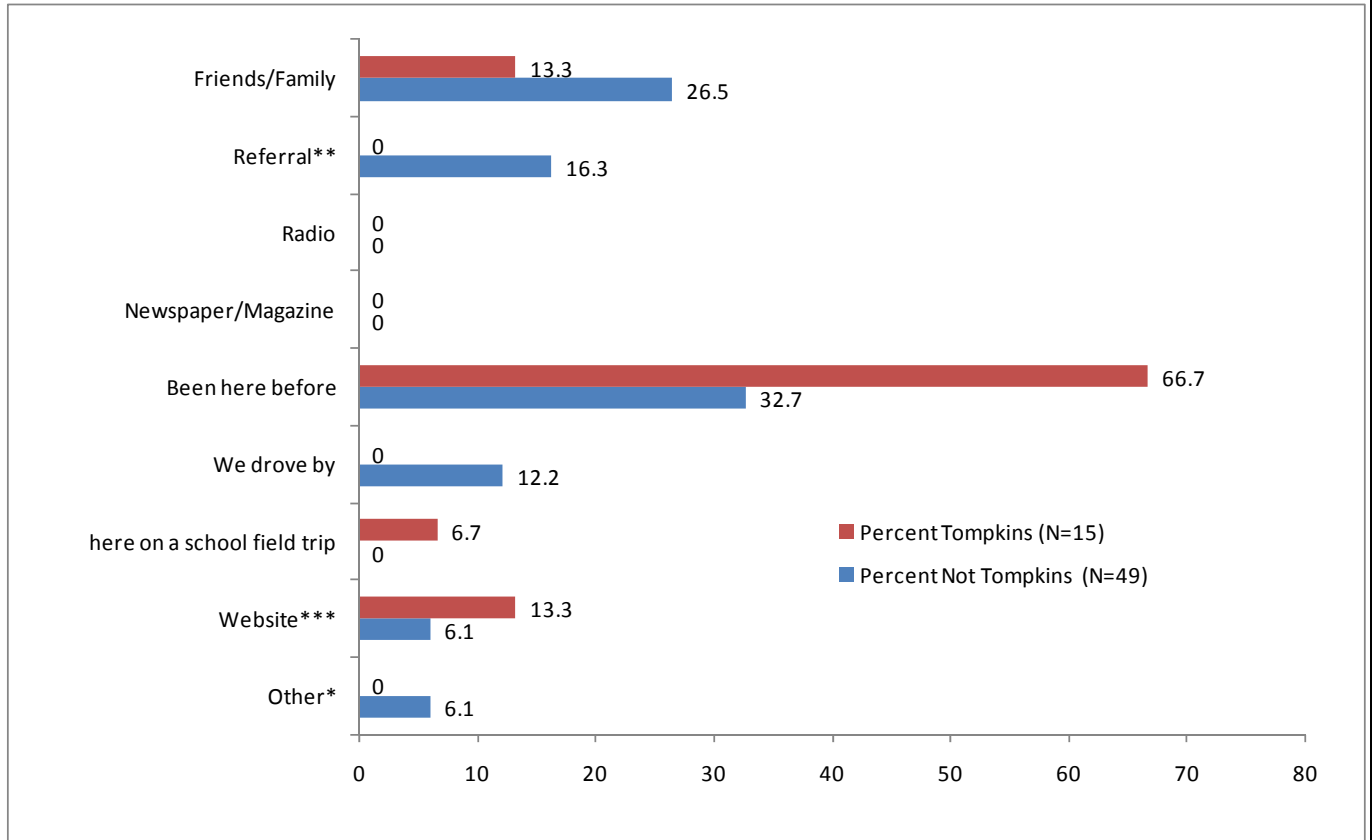

**Figure 5: How They Heard of Discovery Trail Location (Johnson Museum of Art)**

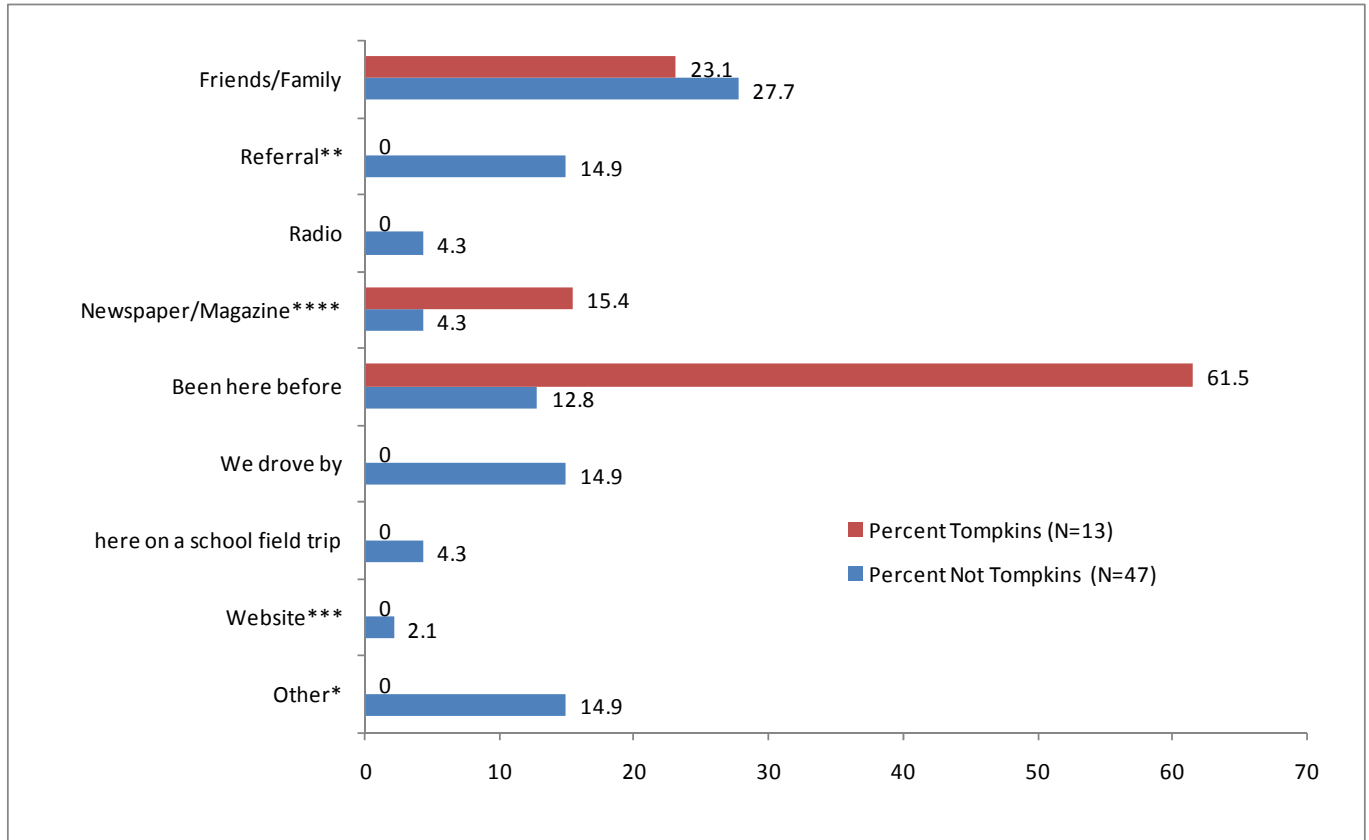

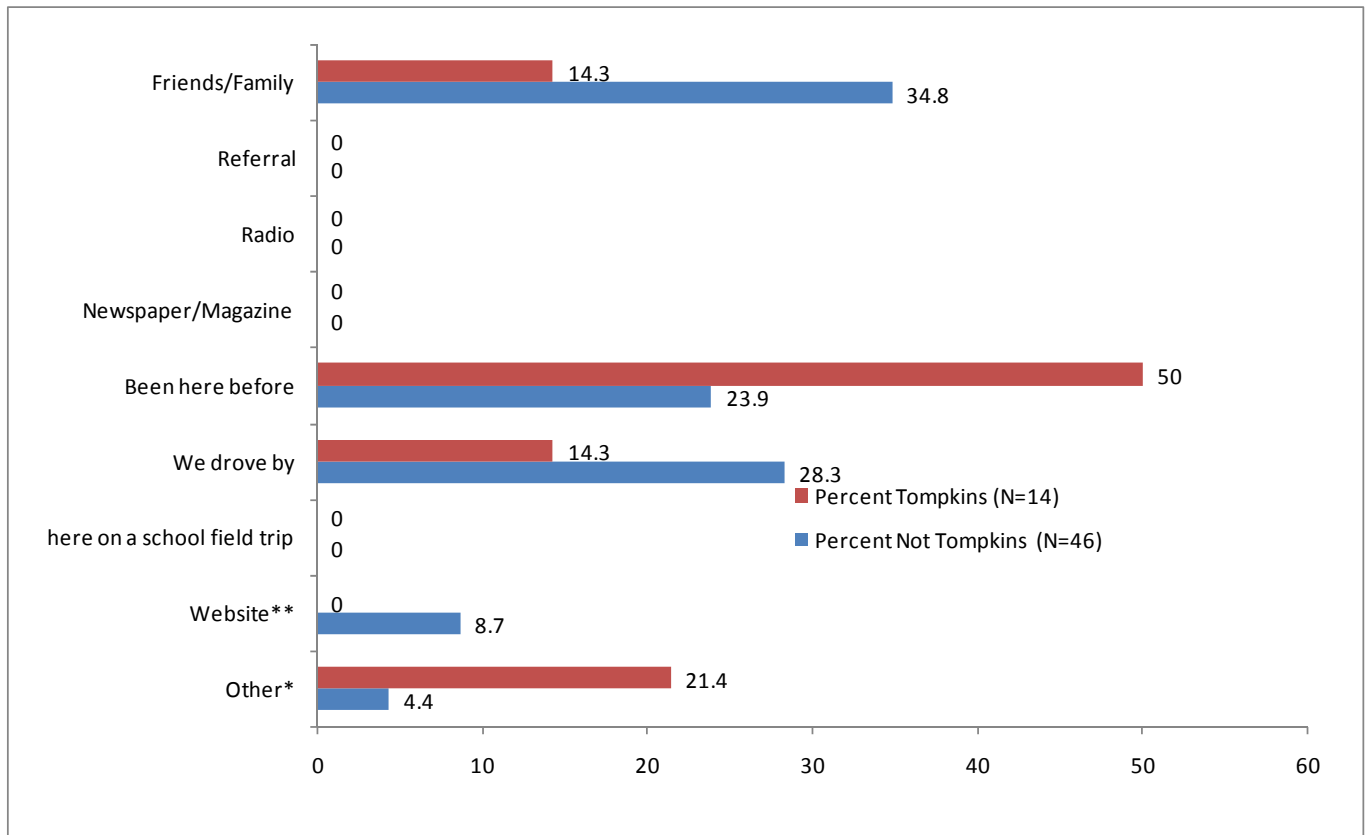

**Figure 6: How They Heard of Discovery Trail Location (Museum of the Earth)**



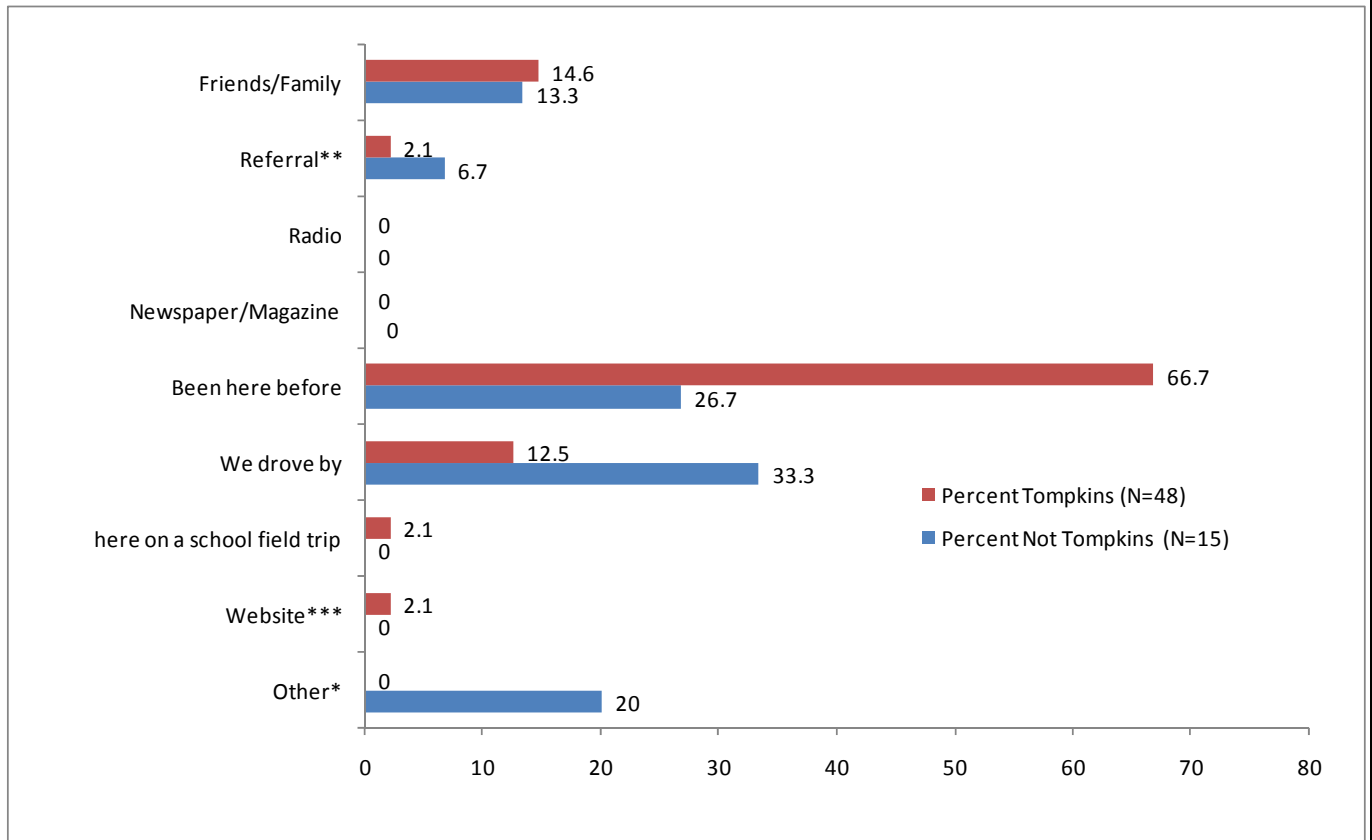

**Figure 8: How They Heard of Discovery Trail Location (Tompkins County Public Library)**

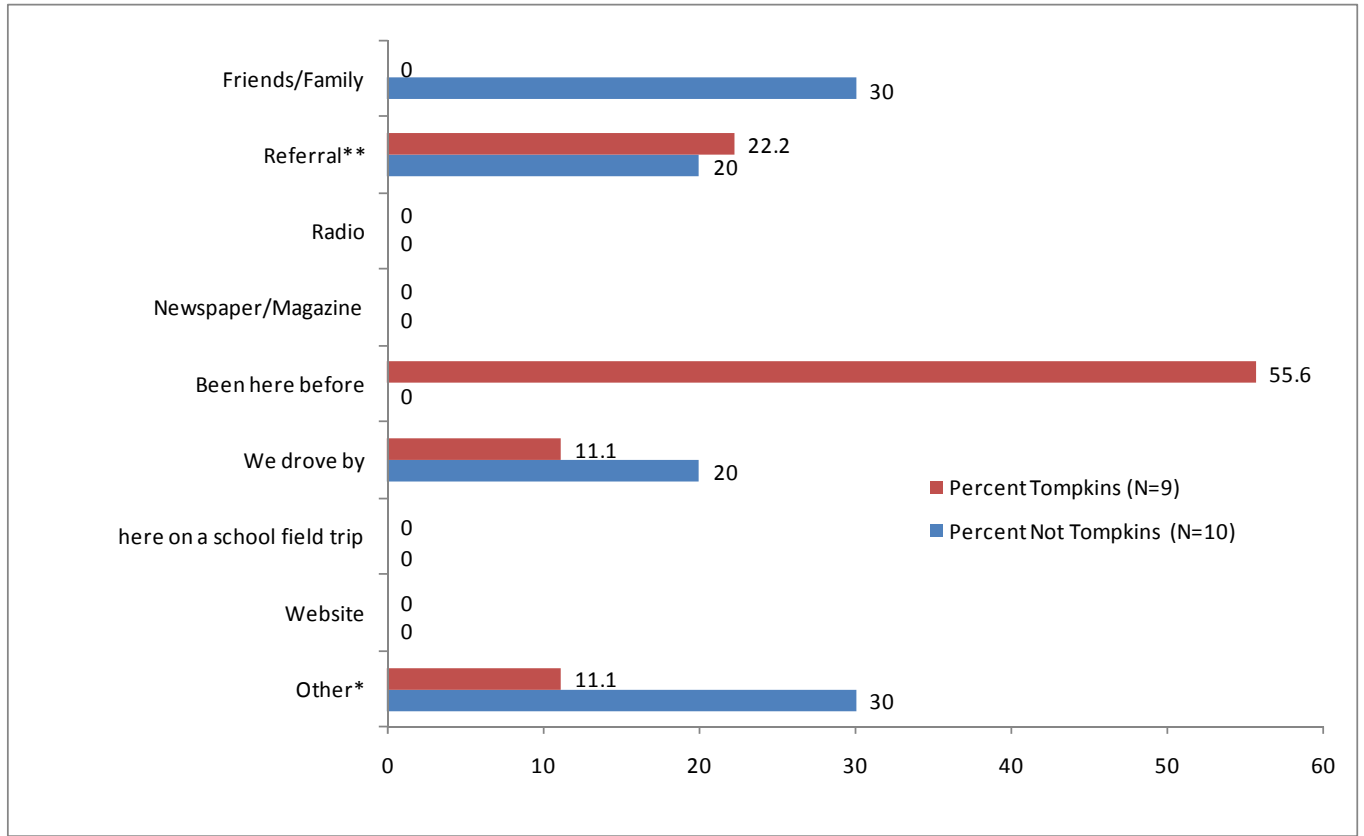

## B. Have They Heard of the Discovery Trail?

When asked if they had heard of the Discovery Trail, almost forty percent of respondents (38.5%) reported that they had heard of the Discovery Trail. Table 6 gives the percentages who said they had heard of the Discovery Trail by location as well as for those who live in Tompkins County versus those who do not. Respondents who were from Tompkins County were almost twice as likely to have heard of the Discovery Trail as respondents not from Tompkins County (58.5% for Tompkins County residents and 26.6% for those outside Tompkins County). However, this trend did not hold true for each individual location. At the Sciencenter, 64.3% of residents of Tompkins County responded they had heard of the Discovery trail versus only 19.6% of non-residents. Though the sample size is small, 60% of Tompkins County residents visiting the History Center heard of the Discovery Trail, while only 20% of non-residents had. There were some similarities. For example, visitors from outside Tompkins County were most likely to report hearing of the Discovery Trail at the Tompkins County Public Library (46.7%) and the Cayuga Nature Center (40.9%). Respondents from Tompkins County were for the most part more likely to report knowledge of the Discovery Trail at the Tompkins County Public Library (75%), the Sciencenter (64.3%), the History Center (60%), and the Johnson Museum of Art (60%).

**Did any of the Discovery Trail locations have an influence on their decision to visit Ithaca/Tompkins County?**

Those visitors who said they had heard of the Discovery Trail were then asked if any of these locations had an influence on their decision to visit Ithaca or Tompkins County. Table 7 reports the percentage of out-of-county visitors who said that the Discovery Trail location influenced their decision to visit Ithaca or Tompkins County. Two thirds (66.7%) of out-of-county visitors said that the Sciencecenter influenced their decision to visit Ithaca/Tompkins County. Forty-four percent of Cayuga Nature Center visitors were influenced to visit Tompkins County based on that location. One out of three Cornell Lab of Ornithology visitors said that the Discovery Trail location influenced their decision to visit.

Those not from Tompkins County were asked how many nights they stayed in Tompkins County on their visit. The average length of stay was 5 nights. Table 8 shows where the visitors stayed during their visit. A plurality (41.3%) stayed with family or friends. Five respondents stayed at the Hilton Garden Inn. The Ramada Inn and the Comfort Inn were cited by 4 respondents each. Three respondents said they stayed at the Taughannock Farms Inn. Only 8 respondents stayed in a bed and breakfast.
